exceptional hospitality to individuals, churches, schools, and organizations seeking a professional yet casual atmosphere.

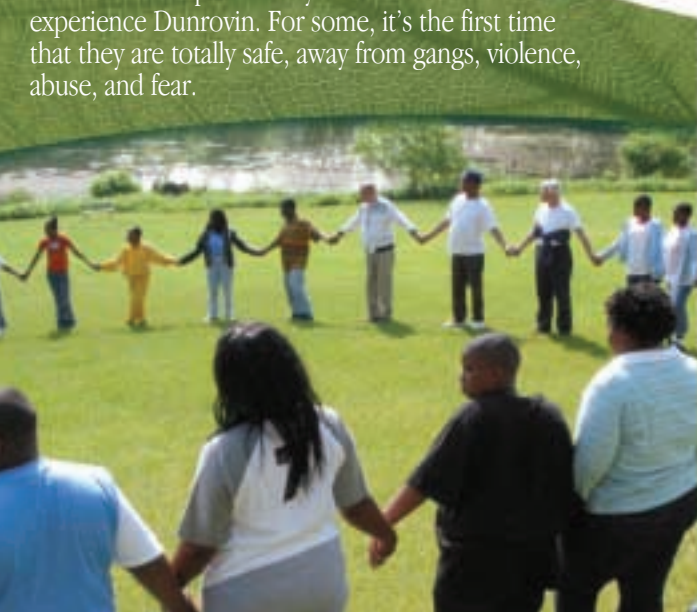
Dunrovin is a **memorable** location for retreats, workshops, meetings, and events.

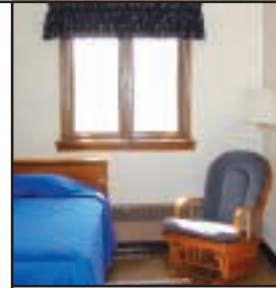




Facilities ... Clean and Comfortable

Our ample meals are home cooked and served buffet style. With notice, we cheerfully accommodate most special diets. Coffee and tea are always available.



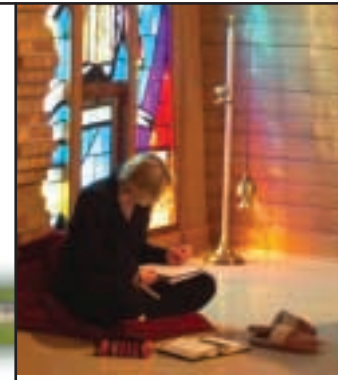
Single rooms have a twin bed, cozy chair, desk, sink, and mirror. Lavatories and showers are on each floor. Suites include private baths.
