- For the guys session I had to step out of my comfort zone – this I will take away.
- The joy of serving.
- The importance of compassion and love.

- I can be bold and risky mistakes are good experiences. I need to have self-knowledge so that I can fight against sadness that may dwell within.

What will you take away from training?

- How to trust my team, how to work together as a team.
- Try and live above the line all the time, say “maybe” when I don’t want to see the other’s opinion, each day, choose to make it a good day.
- The 90/10 rule, the 80/20 and everything about leadership.
- Stepping outside your comfort zone, leading through being a servant, working together, learning the lessons from the mistakes but forgetting the mistake.
- I am the one to choose to have a good or bad day. You get out of it what you put into it.
